Maatrutva Program

The Program educates pregnant women from underserved communities about health care during pregnancy thereby encouraging them to inculcate health seeking behaviour in them for safe deliveries



88 Pregnant women from underserved communities were registered this month to provide telephonic informative sessions



241 Sessions were conducted with registered women informing them about pre-natal care



13% Women registered were in their first Trimester



796 Follow-Up calls were made because of which **362** ANC visits were made possible

Outcome Assessment

We follow up with our beneficiaries on regular intervals to understand the outcome of services



99% Women have given colostrum to their new born baby



95% of the new born babies have been at or over 2.5 kgs which is considered to be healthy in infants



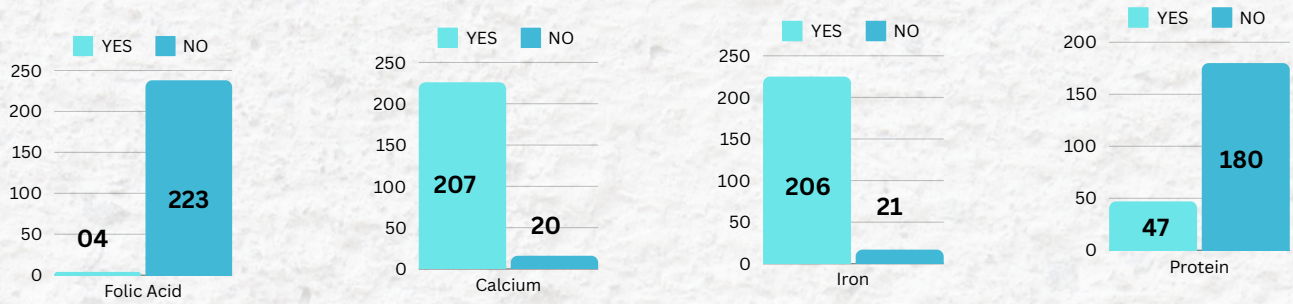
99% Women have been feeding their new born every 2 hours



1% Women in the community have started using contraceptives post delivery

Follow up with registered pregnant women about the status of supplements received during the course of their pregnancy. The below data is out of **227** calls made this month

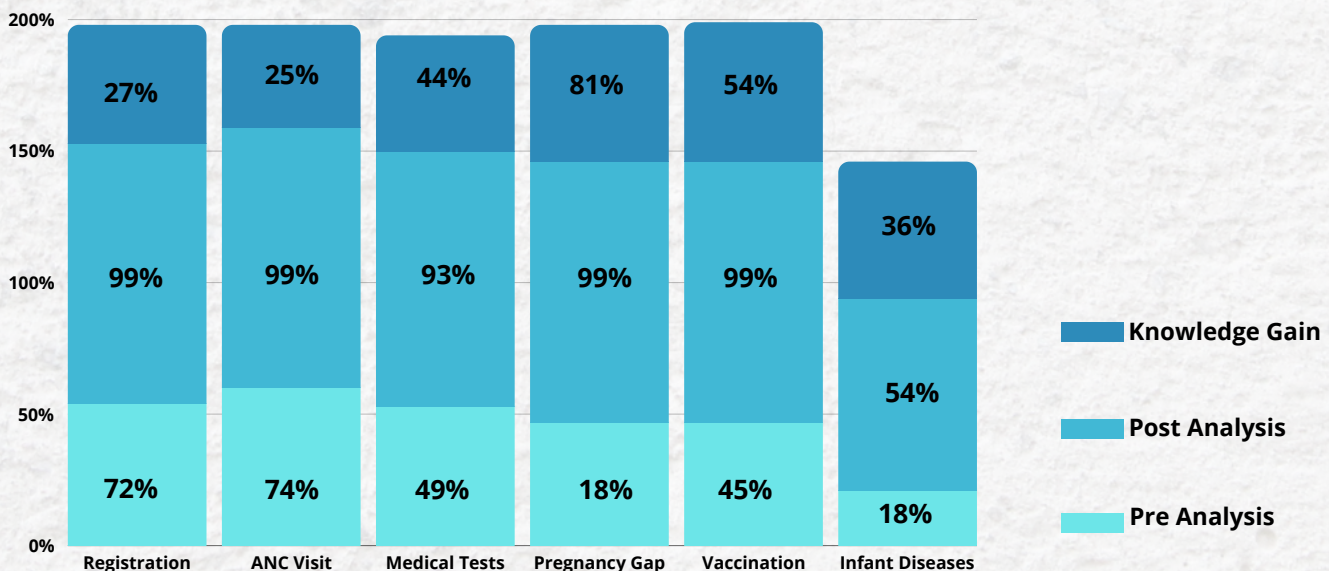


HB Level Analysis of women

18 Patients and caregivers were provided with an extended accommodation facility at Dr. Ernest Borges Memorial Home, Bandra

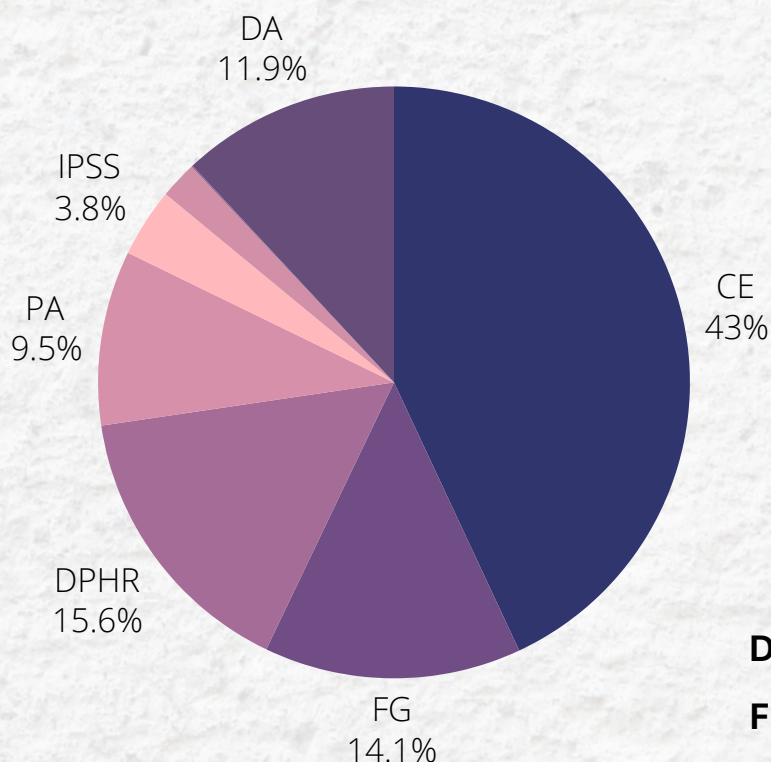


12807 Services were provided to patients in need
